(All cats MUST be entered in their respective Challenge or Award of Merit classes & all kittens in correct classes (M9, F9, M7, F7, M5, F5) and reduced fees do NOT apply to compulsory classes. Litters compete in breeds -- rest in colour & breed.)

"EASY ENTRY FORMS"

With our summary sheets, you save time when entering several exhibits, and we save time if you complete your Vetting slip.

If an exhibit was entered in a Tandanya Show in 1993 -2007, and if his/her parents were shown correctly in that Show catalogue, you may leave the lines for Sire & Dam blank.

All other information MUST be shown on all forms.

E-mail entries -- please send money to reach us by 27/10/08.

Please note: "easy entries" will be acceptable, as Nell is Show Secretary and will be working from the usual database, but remember that this is only permissible when specified on schedules - it makes a lot of extra work for Show Managers/Entry Officers who process entries conventionally.

A.C.F. AWARD all ADULT exhibits now entered automatically.

AWARDS & SPECIALS

PRIZES & Special Award sashes awarded only for Group specials, Best & Reserve of Group, to 10th Best depending on entries (separate awards for Cat, Neuter, Kitten). Will be presented after dismantling of show.

Challenge and Award of Merit Certificates will be handed out from Council Representatives' Table when they are ready.

All Side Class prizes may be collected from Trophy Table during afternoon. Prize cards placed on cages show wins.

The usual "Special Awards" prizes for breeds are replaced by above extended group awards and any "breed awards" (Best of Breed, etc) will be certificate only awards.

PRIVACY - Name and suburb of every exhibitor will be listed in catalogue. Please show on summary sheet if you want other information to be private. Street, phone and/or e-mail address will be included unless you indicate otherwise on entry. (Keep in mind that catalogues are used for sending schedules).

BEST DECORATED CAGE

ENTRY IN THIS CLASS IS FREE - no need to enter.

Judging - 2.00 P.M. All decorated cages will be judged.

Note: welfare/comfort of exhibits is considered in judging.

Domestic & Part Pedigreed Exhibits (Judged together)

At this show, all exhibits will be in their appropriate side classes, except.

Junior Exhibitor (JE) 14 & under - all exhibits in group judged together.

Child (owner) MUST be involved in benching & tending exhibit. Need separate Vet slip.

“JE” must be shown on entry form, with age of exhibitor.

GOVERNING COUNCIL GOLDEN AWARD

Qualifying Heats for 2010 Final will be held at this Show.

(Entry fee: \$4.00 per exhibit.)

Golden Award will be held annually for Governing Council registered Longhairs, Siamese, Foreign Shorthairs and British Shorthairs, with separate classes for Entire Cats and Neuters. All exhibits must be nine (9) months of age or over.

QUALIFYING HEATS may take place at any approved show except the show at which the FINALS take place.

The Finals may take place at a Governing Council Show or at any show nominated by the Governing Council.

The entry fee for the Qualifying Heats is to be four dollars; three dollars of which is to go to the Governing Council.

There will be no entry fee for the FINALS, but cats concerned must enter a Challenge or Award of Merit class.

If there are up to nine (9) entries in a Qualifying class, the judge may award two Qualifiers and a Reserve. If there are ten to fourteen entries, the judge may award three Qualifiers and a Reserve. If there are fifteen to nineteen entries, there may be four Qualifiers and a Reserve. For each additional five entries, there may be one additional Qualifier. There will be no minimum entries required for the class to be held.

Qualifiers are eligible to enter the Finals but may not enter any more Qualifying Heats during the current Golden Award Year. Reserves are eligible to enter the Finals if any of the Qualifiers from their Heat are not benched. Reserves may attempt to Qualify in their own right at other shows in same Golden Award Year, and if successful, are then Qualifiers.

Judges may withhold any placings if they do not consider that there are entries of sufficient merit. Exhibits who Qualify after the closing of entries for the Finals carry over into the Finals of the next Golden Award Year.

Governing Council will make available to shows holding Qualifying Heats, a suitable prize card. For the Finals, Council will provide a prize card, a sash or rosette, and the following prize monies:-

For 2006/2007 Golden Award Finals

All Entire sections:-

First - \$50.00 Second - \$30.00 Third - \$20.00

All Neuter sections:-

First - \$50.00 Second - \$30.00 Third - \$20.00

(Changed to same for entire/neuter – July 2000.)

GUIDELINES FOR ACF AWARD

1. All adult cats are eligible.
2. All eligible cats must be entered in the class by the Show Secretary. The class is to be a **FREE CLASS**.
3. Maximum Certificates to be awarded per show :
One certificate per SEX per GROUP
i.e. no more than six (6) certificates to be awarded per show for entires.
no more than six (6) certificates to be awarded per show for desexed.
4. In the case of a “multiple ring” show, each ring to be considered as a “separate show” and certificates to be awarded accordingly.
5. Record of certificates issued with numbers to be sent to ACF after each show.
6. Applications for **ACF Award of Excellence** must be made on the appropriate form.
7. Applications must be made **THROUGH** the affiliate control.

Applications must be accompanied by **10** original award certificates and sent to the affiliate control.

9. Applications must be accompanied by \$20.00 fee. (cheques etc payable to ACF Inc, please)
10. Affiliates may submit endorsed photocopies of certificates to the ACF Secretariat.
11. Affiliates must submit the prescribed \$20.00 fee with all applications to the ACF Secretariat.

n.b. The awarding of a certificate is to be regarded as a mark of excellence in a particular exhibit. It is not to be regarded as an automatic award in any respect.

Open to all adult cats registered with ACF & CCA affiliates (of breeds, colours and patterns recognised by ACF).

ACF Change - 2006 - to be eligible must be in the Top Five Finals of each Group (1-2-3).

Note that this class is no longer restricted to titled cats..

There are now several higher levels (total of eight).

Please Remember: All entries must be in writing, accompanied by correct entry fees, and in hands of Show Secretary by closing date.

SHOW CLASSES & CODES & SHOW INFORMATION

FROM SHOW RULE 1.1:

"All Pedigreed exhibits five months of age and over on the day of the show and domiciled in S.A. for three months must be individually registered with GCCFSA or FASA.

All Pedigreed exhibits under five months of age on the day of the show must be litter registered."

Rule 6: Show Managers must be notified of any exhibit's change of status as soon as possible and not later than the Monday prior to show, otherwise the exhibit will be outclassed.

Rule 7: All exhibits must have their front claws trimmed. (Trimming means removal of sharp tip.)

EXTRACT FROM Rule 8.4: "Should an exhibit be rejected because it shows symptoms of or may be suffering from a contagious disease the exhibitor must remove all the exhibits they have entered in the show from the venue immediately."

Rule 12.2.2. After use, litter trays must be covered with a lid, or fully enclosed in a strong plastic bag and taken home for disposal. 12.3. Trays and litter must be provided by exhibitor.

RULE 13.8.1: "Any person who does not notify the Show Manager or Show Committee, prior to the erection of cages, that they will not be exhibiting any or all of their cats entered, or any person who does not notify the Show Manager within seven (7) days after the Show, the reason for their non attendance, may be disqualified from exhibiting at future shows."

Rule 26.1. Only Governing Council registered cats can be eligible for Governing Council Honours status, Medallion Awards, and Governing Council Golden Awards, and Governing Council End of Year Awards.

Rule 27. Cats dual registered with GCCFSA and FASA: Exhibitors must show both registrations/numbers on entry forms, and may use GCCFSA or FASA titles, to be eligible for GCCFSA End of Year Points.

Extract from Rule 19.4: Exhibits are to remain in their allotted cages for the duration of the show. ...

... Exhibits should under no circumstances be removed from the immediate vicinity of their cages unless under the direction of a Judge, Veterinary Surgeon, Steward or Show Manager.

GCCFSA EXHIBITOR CODE OF ETHICS (2006)

- Show all due courtesy and respect to the Show Manager &/or Committee of the day.
- Carry out any directive given by the Show Manager, or any who hold office both at Club or Governing Council level, in a pleasant & co-operative manner.
- Comply with all Governing Council Show rules.
- Desist from any unnecessary complaints.
- Display a pleasant & friendly attitude to other exhibitors and congratulate the winners.
- Hold the Judge in the highest respect and treat him/her in like manner.
- During judging NO comments on exhibits, within the judge's hearing or challenge the judge's decision.
- No talking during judging or any interaction with the judge will be reserved until completion of judging unless instigated by the judge. If unsure just when judging has finished ask the Show Manager.
Any offender will be asked to leave the area by the Judge or Show Manager.
- If the request is ignored the Judge or Show Manager has the right to disqualify that exhibitor's cat/s.
- No unsportsmanlike behaviour will be tolerated and the Club could reserve the right to refuse any future entries from any offender.
- Refrain from packing up until the Show Manager permits.
- Mobile phones will be turned off.
- Flash-light photos with Show Managers permission only.

Reminder:

Cats are entered at owner's risk and while we do all we can to ensure their safety, the owner is ultimately responsible for looking after his/her exhibits.

If you look around show halls, you often see signs on the wall, including:

SHOW RULE 19.4**CATS MUST REMAIN IN THEIR CAGES AT ALL TIMES**

Exhibits are to remain in their allotted cage for the duration of the show. Exhibits may be handled by their owners for legitimate purposes, such as feeding, watering, providing litter trays, or showing to other exhibitors or members of the public. However, handling or exhibits by their owners should not be done in proximity to, or in clear view of an officiating judge. Exhibits should under no circumstances be removed from the immediate vicinity of their cage, unless under the direction of a Judge, Veterinary Surgeon, Steward or Show Manager.

This rule is for the safety of you cats and other cats. Please do not put them at risk!

Please use designated areas and do not block exits or cause inconvenience to other exhibitors.
